

## **LOCAL RULES**

1. **Out of Bounds** (Rule 18.2)

The boundary edge is defined by the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of stakes or in the case of a fence; it follows the course side of the pillars and the palisades or wires.

2. **Abnormal Course Conditions** (Rule 16.1)

2.1 **Ground Under Repair (GUR)**

Is defined by a notice or any area encircled by a white painted line or white painted bricks.

2.2 **Immovable Obstructions**

Free relief is available for all artificially surfaced roads as well as all service roads.

3. **Protection of Trees** (Rule 16.1f)

Trees identified by a **BLUE** pvc pipe stake are NO PLAY ZONES. If interference exists by the staked tree or it's bowl with the lie of the ball, stance or intended swing of the player, the player **MUST** take free relief under R16.1f.

4. **Relief from electrical fence** (Model Local Rule E-7)

If a player's ball lies on the course within 2 club-lengths of the electrical boundary fence parallel to the N7, the player may take free relief under Rule 16.1, using as a reference point the point that is 2 club-lengths from the fence and equal distance from the hole.

5. **Code of Conduct** (Rule 1.2b)

A Code of Conduct, with penalties for a breach of its standards is adopted by the Committee. See separate document.

**Breach of a Local Rule: General Penalty  
(Stroke Play: 2 Strokes & Match Play: Loss of Hole)**

All fairway distances are to the centre of the putting green

Pin Positions on the greens:

White flag - front third, Yellow flag - centre third & Red flag – rear third



## **ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES**

Revised 1 October 2021

Please refer to the local rules as displayed on the back of the scorecard. The following Temporary Additional Local Rules apply.

1. Placing by hand within one card length not nearer the hole on the fairway in play only.
2. A free drop is permitted from all paved roads as well as the service road running parallel to the N7 left of holes 1/10, 2/11, 3/12.
3. A free drop, within one club length from the closest point of relief not nearer the hole, is permitted from the water furrows in the service roads. Relief is measured from the edge of the furrow and not from the side of the road.
4. To speed up play, if a player hits the ball out of bounds, the player may decide not to replay the shot and drop a ball on the fairway in line with the point where the ball crossed the out of bounds. The player incurs a two-shot penalty.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The special covid rules relating to flagsticks and bunkers are no longer valid.
